



GENERAL PROCUREMENT NOTICE

The Government of the Republic of Honduras has received grant funding of Fifteen Million Six Hundred and Fifty Thousand United States Dollars (USD 15,650,000.00) from the Millennium Challenge Corporation (MCC) of the United States Government to enable the Government of Honduras to implement the activities and achieve the objectives of the MCC Threshold Program Grant Agreement, and it intends to apply parts of the proceeds of the funds to payments for Contracts for Goods, and Services.
